Wisconsin CPCP

Wisconsin Child Psychiatry Consultation Program is a pilot grant project awarded to the Medical College of Wisconsin to support a child's or adolescent's primary care provider in diagnosing and managing mild to moderate mental health problems. This includes assisting with determining the most appropriate treatment and making recommendations for referrals to other mental health professional and community resources. The pilot project is being conducted in Milwaukee County and 15 counties in northern Wisconsin - Ashland, Bayfield, Florence, Forest, Iron, Langlade, Lincoln, Marathon, Oneida, Portage, Price, Sawyer, Taylor, Vilas and Wood Counties. A physician must be enrolled in the program to access these services.

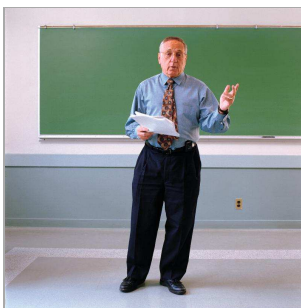
